

## Aviation Department

EWR's YTD June passenger traffic was up only 0.3%. Since the beginning of the year, it had consistently experienced the deepest seat contraction among our airport system. As of YTD June domestic seat capacity is down 3.9%. This translates into a loss of nearly 600,000 seats. The contraction is attributable primarily to two carriers: United and Delta. Their domestic seat capacities are down 6% and 14% respectively. As of YTD June International seat capacity has declined 5%, translating into a loss of nearly 400,000 seats. United, the airport's dominant carrier reduced seat capacity by 7%, and the airport's YTD international traffic was down 0.1%.
