

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ JUNE 2014 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

YTD June EWR's traffic is down 0.1%. mostly due to the 0.8% drop in domestic traffic. The airport's runway closure was the principal reason for the decline, forcing dominant carrier United to reduce domestic capacity by 4.9% and carry about 382,000 fewer passengers. Losses were concentrated, especially in Dallas, Las Vegas and Cleveland. In contrast, YTD June international traffic eked out a 1.5% gain as it benefited from services of relatively new entrants Cathay Pacific, TACA, Iceland and JetBlue's new Santiago service. Down nearly 7% as of YTD Cargo remains weak due to 11% decline in FedEx's volume.
