

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ JUNE 2014 TRAFFIC REPORT

YTD June passenger traffic was up 4.2%. All of JFK's growth was led by the international sector where YTD June traffic grew 7.4% on a 10.1% gain in seat capacity. Growth was led by incumbent carriers Delta, JetBlue, and Emirates, along with new carrier Norwegian and returning carrier Aerolineas Argentina. YTD Domestic traffic at JFK had been weakened and was up only 0.8% because American, the third-ranked carrier, reduced seat capacity by 8.6%, mostly to Los Angeles and San Francisco, and dropped its Fort Lauderdale service. With June YTD 2.3% growth JFK's cargo has recovered primarily due to the 4% gain in international cargo. YTD domestic cargo is 4.8%.
