

Aviation Department

YTD June traffic growth is up only 0.7%. Although Spirit, the airport's dominant carrier, is showing 4.4% YTD growth, weaknesses in the Fort Lauderdale, West Palm Beach and Tampa markets portend weaker traffic patterns ahead. United Airlines' departure from ACY was reflected by a loss of 8,915 passengers, and even though new entrant Air Canada has thus far contributed 1,249 passengers, it is not enough to overcome the deficit created by United.
