

Aviation Department

The growth that propelled JFK's into record territory last year was sustained in the first half of 2015. YTD passenger grew 6.5%, as domestic and international seat capacity grew 6.7% and 4.2% respectively, leading to corresponding 8.8% domestic and 4.5% international passenger growth. Domestic growth was led, in order, by incumbent carriers Delta, JetBlue, and American, along with Virgin America, who collectively added a net of 1.15 million passengers. All regions except Central-South America contributed to the growth. With YTD JFK cargo up 1% following sporadic monthly international growth, JFK is no longer the growth front-runner, having relinquished that role to EWR.
