

Aviation Department

Following a monthly average growth rate of 8.8 percent during the first three months, total passenger traffic at LGA slowed to 0.8 percent, but still reached a record 2.5 million passengers. This increase was driven by a 2.1 percent improvement in domestic traffic. Airlines cut domestic seat capacity by 1.4 percent - 41,938 fewer seats - led by Delta, Southwest, and United. Consistent with a pattern established in the previous three months, international traffic was down 19.1 percent. The drop in international passengers was led by American and Westjet, which carried a combined 28,319 fewer international passengers. Airlines cut international seat capacity by a 0.7 percent, down 7,842 sets. LGA's cargo activity was up 3.2 percent. Domestic cargo grew 2.9 percent. International cargo activity increased 67 percent.
