

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ FEBRUARY 2016 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Total passenger traffic at LGA increased 8.2 percent and reached a February record 1.9 million passengers. The increase, driven exclusively by a 9.7 percent improvement in domestic traffic, was led by Southwest with a 26.6 percent jump, which translates to 37,072 additional domestic passengers. Airlines increased domestic seat capacity by 2.6 percent, a total of 71,352 additional seats, led by AA and Delta. International traffic was down 13.7 percent, despite a 9.2 percent increase in seat capacity. The fall in international passengers was led by Air Canada and American. LGA's cargo activity was up 1.3 percent. Southwest Airlines and US Airways/United accounted for the majority of the increased freight activity. On the other hand, international cargo activity fell 50 percent, led by Air Canada.
