Total passenger activity at LGA reached a record of 2.08 million travelers (+67,254 passengers/+3.3 percent) a year after LGA was significantly affected by Winter Storm Grayson, which led to the cancellation of more than 90 percent of its operations for the duration of the storm. Carriers grew their domestic seat capacity by 82,194 seats (+2.9 percent). LGA's international passenger volume, too, landed in record territory, reaching 141,986 travelers (+5,069 passengers/+3.7 percent). International seat capacity increased by 14,774 seats (+6.7 percent). Air Canada increased its capacity by 11,718 seats to Toronto (+8,842 seats/+9.4 percent) and Montreal (+2,876 seats/+8.7 percent). American added 3,452 seats (+16.4 percent) to Toronto (+3,776 seats/+34.7 percent) and Nassau (+1,024 seats/+100 percent, with service that began in December 2018), while American continued to cut seats to Montreal (-1,348 seats/-13.3 percent). LGA's total freight activity fell by 4.2 percent (-20 tons).
