

Aviation Department

Total passenger traffic at LGA increased 8 percent and reached a March record of 2.5 million passengers. The increase, driven wholly by an 8.9 percent increase in domestic traffic, was led by American/US Airways and Delta. These two carriers transported a combined 162,962 additional domestic passengers. Domestic seat capacity inched slightly lower - down 0.5 percent. International passenger traffic was down 6.9 percent, despite a 6.2 percent increase in seat capacity. The fall in international passengers was led by American, which carried 20,176 fewer passengers. LGA's total cargo volume was up 3.8 percent. American/US Airways led the growth in domestic cargo, which grew 3.5 percent. International cargo, which accounts for an insignificant share of total cargo traffic, rose 50 percent.
