

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic fell (12.0%), while international traffic deteriorated (12.1%) on (3.1%) fewer flights, with the domestic loss at (11.9%) on a (2.6%) drop in flights, with carriers inching closer to balancing supply with demand. Freight declined (21.3%) with freighter operations falling (14.5%).
