

Aviation Department

Kennedy traffic declined (10.2%). Domestic traffic fell (7.2%), while International traffic declined by (13.7%). Freight declined (34.0%), just slightly ahead of year-to-date results. This was split between (28.1%) domestic and (35.4%) international losses. Freighter flights were down (32.2%).
