

For the first time since May 2008, SWF's monthly passenger traffic grew 8.2% in Mar. bringing YTD Mar. growth to positive territory at 0.2% as Delta and US Airways added additional capacity to Detroit and Philadelphia. As the economy improves, we anticipate traffic to continue its growth and end the year in positive territory.
