

LGA continued to lead the region with first-quarter growth of 3.7% on a 7.7% capacity gain and domestic growth of 3.8%. Domestic gains were led by Delta, which carried 110,934 more passengers. The international sector lost some momentum as March's 10% decline slowed traffic growth to only 0.4%. The international traffic decline was due to significant reductions by USAirways and Delta to Nassau in the Bahamas.
