

Aviation Department

First quarter passenger traffic was up 5.7%. Airlines have cut domestic and international seat capacity, but planes are much fuller, as passenger traffic grew 5.8% and 5.6% respectively. In contrast, cargo remained weak as first quarter result indicated a 7% decline.
