

First quarter passenger traffic was up 5.8%. Domestic seats, accounting for 96% of total seats, was down nearly 2%. In spite of this, first quarter domestic passengers grew 5.3%. The international sector gained momentum as traffic grew 19.9% on a 12% seat capacity gain, led by AA and Air Canada to Montreal and Toronto. Cargo was up 8.3%.
