

## Aviation Department

First quarter traffic was up 2.2% at SWF, the result of an 8.4 % seat capacity expansion by US Airways to Philadelphia. Both JetBlue and Delta traffic was down due to seat capacity reductions to Ft. Lauderdale and Detroit respectively Cargo was up nearly 18%.
