

## Aviation Department

SWF continued to experience passenger attrition as first quarter traffic fell nearly 20%. Overall seat capacity dropped 18% and all three carriers operated fewer seats and carried fewer passengers. With reduced services to Florida destinations, JetBlue, the No. 1 ranked carrier, carried 1,000 fewer passengers. With the cessation of services to its connecting hub at Atlanta, Delta lost the most seats (-20,800) and the most passengers (-15,590).
