

Aviation Department

At EWR, domestic traffic eked out 0.7% growth as gains by Virgin America (which began operations in April 2013), Southwest, and Delta overshadowed a decline of nearly 100,000 passengers by hub carrier United. Unless planes are remarkably full, a scheduled 8.4% reduction in domestic seat capacity does not bode well for the airport in April. Cargo decline continues to worsen at EWR. Domestic cargo, accounting for 67% of the airport's total, was down 13.6%, and international was down 0.5%.
