

## Aviation Department

Since February 2013, domestic traffic at JFK has been weak because JetBlue and Delta had been reducing capacity and carrying fewer passengers. The pattern continued through the first quarter and was compounded by cancellations, leading to a 3.2% decline in domestic traffic. With a first-quarter gain of 3.2%, international traffic continued to lead the airport's growth, assisted by new carriers Norwegian and TAME, returning carrier Aerolineas Argentina, and incumbent carriers Delta, JetBlue and Emirates, who collectively added a net of 286,000 passengers. March monthly cargo was up 3.7%, the first monthly gain since May 2013, pushing YTD cargo up 0.1%.
