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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

March passenger and freight data continue a recent gentle southward pattern. Easter fell in April in both years and did not affect traffic comparisons. Regional passenger traffic grew 3.2%, supported by strong 13.9% JFK growth. Freight traffic declined 5.8% following recent downward movements seen in American Transport Association data.
