The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

...Another sound recovery month. Regional passenger traffic rises 5% on strong domestic growth. American Transport Association member airlines report a (1%) traffic decline. Industry is experiencing record load factors, albeit on reduced capacity. July is the first month in many to show a year-over-year increased average passenger ticket prices.
