The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Regional passenger traffic is up 15.3% over last year, on the strength of the economic recovery and the Iraq war's impact on March 2003 numbers. The freight drop is a puzzler.
