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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

October passenger traffic up a strong 6.1% -- fairly evenly spread among the three airports. This is 7 percentage points above the Air Traffic Association member carrier average. Signs of the economy roaring back are appearing, pointing to continued strong results. The puzzle is freight -- of (6%). That's not good, but it is in line with ATA carriers.
