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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Passenger traffic rose a strong 3.2%, led by continued domestic competitive strength. Year-to-date traffic grew 2.4%. International traffic grew more than 1%, continuing its climb back from the Iraq War and SARS lows last Spring. Freight continues to sputter, down (3.9%) in September, with year-to-date up 3.2%.
