

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic fell 8.0% on a 6.8% reduction in seat capacity, a slight improvement over the 10.2% average decline in the first four months. Domestic traffic was down 7.4% on a 6.9% drop in seats. International traffic fell back into negative territory with a 9.3% decrease on 6.5% fewer seats. Transatlantic traffic was down 9.3% as Continental flew 25 thousand or 6.2% fewer passengers in this market, worse than April but better than the three months prior.
