

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic declined by 4.2 percent in May, despite a 5.7 percent seat gain from Delta's affiliate which added 1,870 daily departing seats for a 28.7 percent gain. Delta traffic increased 13.5 percent – unfortunately more than offset by a 17 percent drop from the US Airways affiliate and a 9.9 percent drop in JetBlue traffic. Stewart's cargo operations remain on track, with a 25.1 percent volume increase on 46.9 percent more freighter operations.
