

Aviation Department

SWF continues to experience passenger attrition, as passenger traffic in May fell nearly 9%. Contributing factors include a 7% or 353 seat decline by US Airways to Philadelphia and Delta's 3% seat reduction of flights to Detroit. More importantly, Jetblue, the number one ranking carrier at the airport downgraded its fleet by switching from 158-seat A320 to smaller 100-seat regional jet for flights to Fort Lauderdale and Orlando. This led to a decline of 33% or 3,100 fewer seats on these routes. SWF's cargo which makes up less than 1 percent of the region's cargo was up 27%.
