

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic rose 3% with international up 6.4% and domestic down 0.5%. YTD is up 1%. Dominant carriers on domestic routes such as JetBlue, AA and Virgin America collectively carried 54,000 fewer passengers due to their reduction in seat capacity. JetBlue cut the capacity by 4.7%, AA offered 1.9% less and Virgin America reduced seats by 15%. International travel gained steam because airlines increased seat capacity by 3.7%. Cargo decreased 1.6%. Although domestic cargo was up 1%, a 2.2% contraction in international tonnage pulled the sector down due to its hefty 80% share of the airport's total cargo.
