

Aviation Department

It was yet another good month for LGA as it continued its strong growth with YTD passenger traffic up 6.2%. Combined international and domestic traffic in May was up 3%. Although US Airways, American, Frontier and UA/CO combined carried 151,000 fewer domestic passengers, Delta, JetBlue, Spirit and Southwest Airlines together served 170,000 more travelers, lifting domestic traffic by 0.9%. The international sector continued its strong growth with WestJet and Delta contributing the most to 46.9% increase with expanded services to major Canadian cities.
