

Aviation Department

ACY's growth is capped this month at 3.9% compared to double-digit increases of previous month. The reason for this was Spirit Airline's surprising seat capacity attrition for May. Even though carriers' passenger traffic increased 1.6%, its seat capacity experienced a decrease of 1.2% primarily cutting seats to Myrtle Beach and Orlando. In contrast, Frontier Airlines operating at nearby Trenton airport expanded its seat capacity by 27.8% to Orlando. This may signal a ratchet-up of competition from Trenton. We intend to monitor further developments. Out of 4,400 incremental passengers at ACY this month, United accounted for 2,900 with its services to Houston and Chicago.
