

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ MAY 2014 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

Passenger traffic is up 12.5% at SWF in May on a 8% seat capacity expansion. Even though, this capacity increase was solely Allegiant Air's contribution with a flight to St. Petersburg, Delta's traffic to Detroit was up 17.8%. In fact, out of 3,800 incremental passengers, Delta alone carried 1,154 and the rest belonged to Allegiant Air. JetBlue's traffic was flat but US Airways continued passenger attrition with 7.4% decline. However good this month's traffic is, we remain cautiously optimistic about upcoming summer travels. Cargo declined 8.3% because of FedEx, which is a dominant cargo carrier with close to 65% of SWF's cargo share.
