

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ NOVEMBER 2007 TRAFFIC REPORT

Regional passenger traffic rose 2.5% on a 4.4% increase in seat capacity. American Transport Association member traffic fell (0.6%). JFK again led the region with 7.9% passenger growth. JFK and EWR each had international passenger growth exceeding 10%. Regional Freight declined (4.9%), with 12-month ending freight down (2.1%). ATA member revenue freight ton miles rose 3.5% in November.
