

## Aviation Department

Kennedy traffic declined (7.4%) on a (4.9%) fewer seats, lowering load factors 2.6% on average. Domestic traffic fell (10.2%) on a (8.8%) seat drop, while international traffic fell (3.5%). There were little in the way of big service initiatives in November, mostly the usual seasonal shifting in seat capacity. Transatlantic traffic fell (1.6%) on a 2.5% cut in seats. Freight declined (23.7%). Freighter flights were down (19.7%).
