

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ NOVEMBER 2011 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

Kennedy traffic declined 1.3 percent on flat seat growth, a 0.7 percent domestic loss balanced by a 0.7 percent international increase. Passenger growth split between a 3.6 percent domestic loss and 1.3 percent international gain. By world grouping, only the Pacific and Latin American markets showed gains, growing 3.7 percent and 10.7 percent. Atlantic and Canadian traffic declined 2.1 percent and 6.8 percent, respectively. Freight decreased 9.3 percent, split between 6.4 percent domestic and 10 percent international declines. Freighter operations fell 4.3 percent.
