LaGuardia traffic fell 0.8 percent with a 1 percent domestic loss and 3.6 percent international gain. Overall, scheduled seats at LaGuardia fell 1.9 percent, while Canadian seats increased by 9.4 percent. A look at advance schedules shows Delta will add 29 new nonstop destinations to the 34 destinations Delta currently serves. Fifteen of the new destinations will be starting in March and fourteen in July. Advance schedules show that Delta - by upgauging the average seats per slot acquired from US Airways - will increase LGA annual seats by about 2.550 million.
