

November passenger traffic was up 1.1% placing YTD Nov. growth at 3.4%. International sector led the growth with 5.2% as Brussels Air, a new carrier and Aeroflot collectively added a net 50,000 passengers. Residual impacts of hurricane Sandy caused domestic traffic to fall 2.5%. As a result, the top three carriers, JetBlue, Delta and American collectively carried 62,000 fewer passengers. Cargo grew for the first time this year, due to one-time gain big by FedEx domestic operations. However, YTD Nov. cargo was down 5.3%.
