

With a 9.4% gain in overall seat capacity in Nov. LGA remained the fastest growing among our airports as passenger traffic grew 2.2% in Nov., pushing YTD growth up to 6.3%. While domestic passenger traffic grew only 0.3%, the international sector continued its double digit drive with a growth of 46.7% on a 60% seat capacity gain, due in part to the arrival of new Canadian carrier WestJet and expanded services by Delta to Nassau and by AA and Air Canada to Toronto. Cargo was up 17.9% in Nov. but YTD cargo is down 3.7%.
