Aviation Department

Passenger traffic is up 4 percent at SWF. Although, JetBlue and Delta's combined traffic was down 8.2%, the arrival of Allegiant Air with its service to Tampa, and US Airways' increase lifted the airport's traffic. This is the third consecutive positive month and this growth is expected to continue. Cargo at SWF declined 33% because of sluggish business activity by UPS and structural adjustments of FedEx.
