

## Aviation Department

ACY's passenger traffic was up 5.2% in November, pushing YTD up to 6.9%. Spirit Airlines, the airport's dominant carrier, carried 4.8% more passengers as it expanded capacity to Fort Myers, Orlando and West Palm Beach. United contributed a net of 2,088 passengers this month. However, with the carrier's December departure and Atlantic City's economic woes, next year's outlook for passenger traffic at ACY could be challenging. ACY should end the year with growth of about 6.5% due to strong gains in the beginning of the year.
