

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic increased 4.9% at EWR. Domestic traffic increased at a nice 3.9% clip, but international roared ahead with 7.2% growth, contributing greatly to this month's traffic uptick. United, Cathay Pacific, Austrian Airlines, JetBlue, Porter, SAS, and Lufthansa combined to carry 65,316 more passengers. Domestic travel increased due largely to growth by United, Delta, and JetBlue, which accounted for 77% of November's jump. With 4.9% growth in November, EWR marked its fifth consecutive monthly increase in cargo tonnage. Domestic and international cargo each expanded as airlines carried 2,670 more tons. Both domestic and international contributed. However, domestic had a greater contribution due to its larger share in cargo tonnage, as it grew 4.8%. International cargo increased 4.9%.
