

Aviation Department

JFK has been a major driver of the region's record air travel in 2014. It accounted for 46% of the region's YTD November travel, serving 48.8 million passengers. With a 6.5% increase-the airport's eighth consecutive record-setting month-almost four million passengers traveled through the airport. International travel increased 4.3% and domestic air travel saw the best increase so far with an 8.7% jump. These increases pushed YTD November up 5.8%. Cargo was flat in November. Even though international tonnage increased by 2.2%, a hefty 9.1% contraction in domestic cargo resulted in zero growth.
