

## Aviation Department

Allegiant Air kept its capacity unchanged and increased load factors in November. As a result, Allegiant's traffic was up 32.3%. Travel with US Airways increased 5.2% with its destination to Philadelphia, which primarily serves as a connecting point from and into SWF. However, air travel declined for the remaining two airlines at SWF. JetBlue and Delta combined carried 10.8% fewer passengers. This decline pulled the airport's November traffic down to 3.3% despite Allegiant's and US Airways' contributions.
