

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ NOVEMBER 2015 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

The airport handled 3.1 million passengers - up 9.1 percent - and pushed YTD traffic up 5.5 percent. EWR's traffic growth continued to be led by the domestic sector, which grew 13 percent. Airlines increased domestic capacity by 133,504 seats, or 5.4 percent. Nearly 70 percent of the incremental seats were provided by United. United carried 118,776 additional passengers and accounted for a 46 percent share of the domestic passenger increase. Compression of international seats has pushed YTD passenger growth down a fraction, 0.05 percent. Freight activity at EWR grew 1.3 percent. While domestic cargo grew 2.4 percent, international cargo fell 0.4 percent. YTD cargo continues to perform well - up 5.6 percent - due to strong gains in the first six months by FedEx.
