

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ NOVEMBER 2015 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Total passenger traffic reached 2.3 million. This represents an 8.4 percent increase and was driven by a 9.4 percent climb in domestic traffic. Domestic growth was led by American and Southwest. Combined, these two carriers transported 61,935 domestic passengers. Seat capacity edged slightly down 0.9 percent, which translates to higher aircraft load factors. International traffic was down 6.9 percent, despite a 7.8 percent gain in seat capacity. The fall in international passengers was led by Air Canada and American. These two airlines carried a combined 30,124 fewer international passengers. LGA's cargo activity was up 12.2 percent in November. Southwest and US Airways accounted for the majority of the improvement, handling a combined 139 tons. YTD freight movement at LGA continues to perform exceedingly well, up 9 percent.
