

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ NOVEMBER 2015 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

Total passenger traffic at SWF fell 5.5 percent, with 1,274 fewer passengers. YTD traffic is down 9.1 percent. Airlines cut seat capacity by 15.4 percent, led by Delta and US Air. These two carriers experienced declines in passenger movement in November. Delta had the biggest drop - down 16.3 percent - and US Air registered a 13.6 percent fall. As we have stated in previous reports, with no recovery expected in December, passenger traffic at SWF is likely to fall by 9.6 percent in 2015. Stewart's cargo increased 3.4 percent, the second positive performance of 2015 after October's 10.1 percent gain. YTD cargo traffic is down 3.8 percent.
