

Aviation Department

LaGuardia passenger traffic declined (10.0%), with Domestic down (9.8%) to a (13.6%) international decline. Mainline flights were down less than 1 percent, while Regional operations increased 4.1%. The general aviation sector fell (32%). Spirit added 265 daily seats to its Ft. Lauderdale hub, while AirTran has done a similar build-up at Milwaukee and Richmond.
