

Aviation Department

Kennedy traffic increased 5.6 percent on 5.4 percent more seats. Domestic traffic grew 5.1 percent on 4 percent more seats. The only gains since 2008 occurred in September and October. The long drought affecting domestic capacity seems to be ebbing. International traffic increased 6.1 percent on 6.9 percent more seats. In October, JFK Canadian and the Caribbean markets each grew about 6 percent. Trans-Atlantic traffic grew 6.3 percent, the sixth straight month of gains. Freight volume increased 19.3 percent in October, split between a 7.7 percent domestic and 22.0 percent international gains.
