EWR served 2.9 million passengers, up 14.2% because of Hurricane Sandy's impact on the data. Domestic and international traffic increased 15.5% and 11.3% respectively, pushing YTD traffic up to 2.3%, to a total 29.3 million. This is the 4th consecutive month of traffic growth. Domestic carriers combined served 270,000 more passengers. The lion's share of this increase belongs to United, the dominant carrier, which increased capacity to destinations in California, upstate New York, Texas and New England. In addition to strong gains in the domestic market, the airport's international traffic increase pushed YTD into positive territory, reaching 1%. As United cuts capacity on its international routes, growth is coming from other carriers: Delta, Scandinavian, Air Canada, British Airways and Lufthansa, amongst others.
