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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Our airports served 9.5 million passengers in October 2013. Although this represents a hefty 9.2 percent increase - much higher than the nation's 2.1 percent as reported by A4A - it is largely attributed to distortions caused in last year's totals by Hurricane Sandy, and in part to growth in personal income. From the start of the year, 60.8 million domestic and 33.4 million international passengers used the region's airports for a total of 94.2 million, exceeding pre-recession levels. With YTD traffic up 2.5 percent, our airports are on track to establish another annual record.
