

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ OCTOBER 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic jumped 9.4% at SWF due to last year's severe weather distortions. This is the second consecutive positive month. JetBlue, Delta, US Air and Allegiant collectively carried 2,260 more passengers. The growth at the airport is expected to continue due to Allegiant's new service to Tampa, Florida. Even though Hurricane Sandy distortions resulted in significant gains at other airports, the cargo at SWF declined. Sluggish activity by dominant freighters resulted in a 4.4% decrease this month pushing YTD down to 4.9%.
